You reproduce the contents of a source in a condensed form, focusing on the author's main ideas and reporting them accurately and objectively. You report on the author's ideas but do not evaluate or judge them, so your opinions or ideas shouldn't be included. You must use your own words to express the ideas in the source. If you wish to use the author's words, you must use quotation marks around any words, phrases, and sentences that are the author's.
