### **Section 1: Forming Comparative Adjectives**

Rule	Examples
One <b>■</b> syllable adjectives: add -er	$\begin{array}{l} \text{tall} \rightarrow \text{taller} \\ \text{small} \rightarrow \text{smaller} \\ \text{fast} \rightarrow \text{faster} \end{array}$
Adjectives ending in -y: change $y \rightarrow i$ + -er	happy → happier easy → easier busy → busier
Long adjectives (2+ syllables): use 'more'	beautiful → more beautiful expensive → more expensive interesting → more interesting

### **Section 2: Irregular Comparative Adjectives**

Adjective	Comparative
good	better
bad	worse
far	farther / further
little	less
many/much	more
