Term	Definition	
Footing	A projecting roof structure that shelters an entrance.	
Column	A single window sash hinged on one side that swings open.	
Canopy	A small structure projecting above a roof that provides ventilation and can serve as a "look-out."	
Façade	A theme or predominant feature of a design	
Dentils	The exterior faces of a building, often used to refer to the wall in which the building entry is located.	
Flutes	The enlarged area on which the foundation sits.	
Hearth	On the column shaft, a series of vertical grooves	
Casement	Small blocks, projecting like teeth, in a series	
Cupola	A supporting pillar, consisting of a shaft, base, and capital.	
Motif	A brick, stone, or cement area in front of a fireplace. "The heart of the house."
