Lesson 01: literary genre

Definition of literary genre: a style of expressing yourself in writing

Genre: a kind of literary or artistic work.

Poetry

Verse form: A composition written in meterical feet forming rythmical lines.

Free verse: poetry that does not have rhyme or have regualr meter.

Rhyme: correspondance in the final sounds of two or more line.

Meter: basic unit of length.

Verse: A line of poetry which is composed of two parts

Hemistick: it is part of verse.

Scansion: the rythmic structure.

Foot: the rythmic parts which compose the scansion.

Prosody: the patterns of rhythm and sound used in poetry.

Peg: it represent a vowelled letter.

Cord: it represent unvowelled letter.

Poetry had three principals:

1. <u>Panegyrique</u>: praise of tribe and its elders during the islamic periode. For example the pre – islamic poet Al- Nabighah addressing his ruler:

You are the sun itself, other monarchs are stars

When you light shines bright, the other stars vanish.

- 2. <u>Lampoon</u>: where by the poet would be expected to take verbal aim at the community enemies.
- 3. **Elegy:** praise of the dead
