

## Present perfect tense

### Affirmative Form:

**Subject + have/has + past participle.**

Example : Jane has just started her third semester at the university.

### Negative form:

**Subject + have/has + not + past participle.**

Example : Kevin has not planned to work in that factory.

### Interrogative form:

**Have/Has + subject + past participle?**

Example : Have you ever been to Nova Scotia?
