1) _____

This type of law encompasses the protection of creative works and symbols uniquely developed by individual persons or groups of people.

2) _____

This branch of law concerns land, homes, construction, property boundaries and legal solutions for construction defects like poor infrastructure or inadequate quality, building, or clarity on anything concerning housing and living conditions.

3) _____

Also known as revenue law, this law field assists civilians, organisations, businesses and governmental systems in lawfully participating in the taxation system.

4) _____

This field of law addresses the rights of workers and the relationships they share with their employers.

5) _____

This branch of law involves the formation, dissolution, and all other legal aspects of the administration of corporations. Typical duties of lawyers in this field include mergers, acquisitions, internal reorganization, or disputes between corporations and individuals.

6) _____

In this field of law, the focus is on behaviours that are sanctioned under the criminal code and defined as illegal. Both prosecution and defence professionals deal with issues of individual liberty, basic rights, and responsibilities.

7) _____

While relating to Intellectual Property Law, this area of law is more specifically centred on rights and media royalties issues in the arts, music, television, cinema, or athletics.

8) _____

Legal professionals practicing in this field may represent government agencies, advocacy organizations, or individuals. They often focus on cases involving natural resource management, the curbing of pollution, or disputes about land and littoral use.

9) _____

Lawyers in this field typically work in smaller firms and specialize in a variety of areas ranging from child welfare, through adoption, to divorce. Child abuse, legitimacy, domestic partnerships, and marriages are among the main aspects of these lawyers' practice.

10) _____

This is the body of law which defines the role, powers, and structure of different entities within a state, namely, the executive, the legislature, and the judiciary; as well as the basic rights of citizens and, in federal countries, the relationship between the central government and state, provincial, or territorial governments.
