Present perfect tense

Affirmative Form:

Subject + have/has + past participle.

Example : Jane has just started her third semester at the university.

Negative form:

Subject + have/has + not + past participle.

Example :Kevin has not planned to work in that factory.

Interrogative form:

Have/Has + subject + past participle?

Example :Have you ever been to Nova Scotia?
