

Past CONTINUOUS tense

- **In making a positive simple past statement the pattern is :**

Subject + WAS /WERE+VERB +ING

Eg : You were watching a movie

- **Negative sentence**

Subject+ WAS/WERE NOT+VERB+ING

Eg : you were not watching a movie

- **Interrogative sentence**

WAS/ WERE + subject +verb + ING + ?

Eg : were you watching a movie ?

EXERCISE : turn these sentences into negative form then into the interrogative form in the simple past CONTINUOUS tense :

1. Lucy was cooking lunch .
2. Tim was palying guitar .
3. Helen and Mary were laughing.
4. My mother was reading a magazin.
5. My brother was eating a banana.
